## To review agencies, parties to the proceeding, and interested persons:

On Wednesday, April 7, 2010, the Commission sustained an objection of Intervenor Friends of the Highland Mountains regarding Development Permit DP 4862. The Commission has determined the application submitted by Highland Wind, LLC is not complete because the applicant has not sufficiently demonstrated Right, Title and Interest, as required by law. Accordingly, the Commission will take no further action on this application unless and until the applicant completes its application.

When and if an application is accepted as complete, all notices required by law will be provided. A Public Notice will be published in a locally circulated newspaper, sent to abutting landowners, and posted on LURC's website, indicating a complete application is under review and providing information as to the review process, including deadlines and public hearing.

Any comments submitted by review agencies will be retained, but the previously noticed April 21<sup>st</sup> due date for submittal of review comments by agencies is no longer applicable. When and if an application is accepted as complete, LURC will contact the reviewing agencies to submit, re-confirm or amend review comments.
