We are working hard to reduce our energy consumption across the chain by converting to LED lighting and monitoring and centrally controlling energy systems, by enclosing refrigerated display cases where possible, and reusing the waste heat from our refrigeration systems. We are also investing in creating a more fuel efficient fleet of trucks to deliver products to our stores as efficiently as we can throughout the State and region. In 2009, Hannaford opened the most environmentally advanced supermarket in the world, certified by the US Green Building Council at the Platinum level, the highest level achievable.
