Summary of New England Polling Results Interactive Survey Methodology

Zogby International conducted interviews of 2,590 adults in CA, CT, MA, ME, NH, RI, and VT. Panelists who have agreed to participate in Zogby polls online were invited to participate in the survey. The online poll ran from 1/13/06 through 1/16/06. The margin of error is +/- 3.2 percentage points in the Northeast states sample of 947. Margins of error are higher in sub-groups. Slight weights were added to state, age, race, and gender to more accurately reflect the population.
