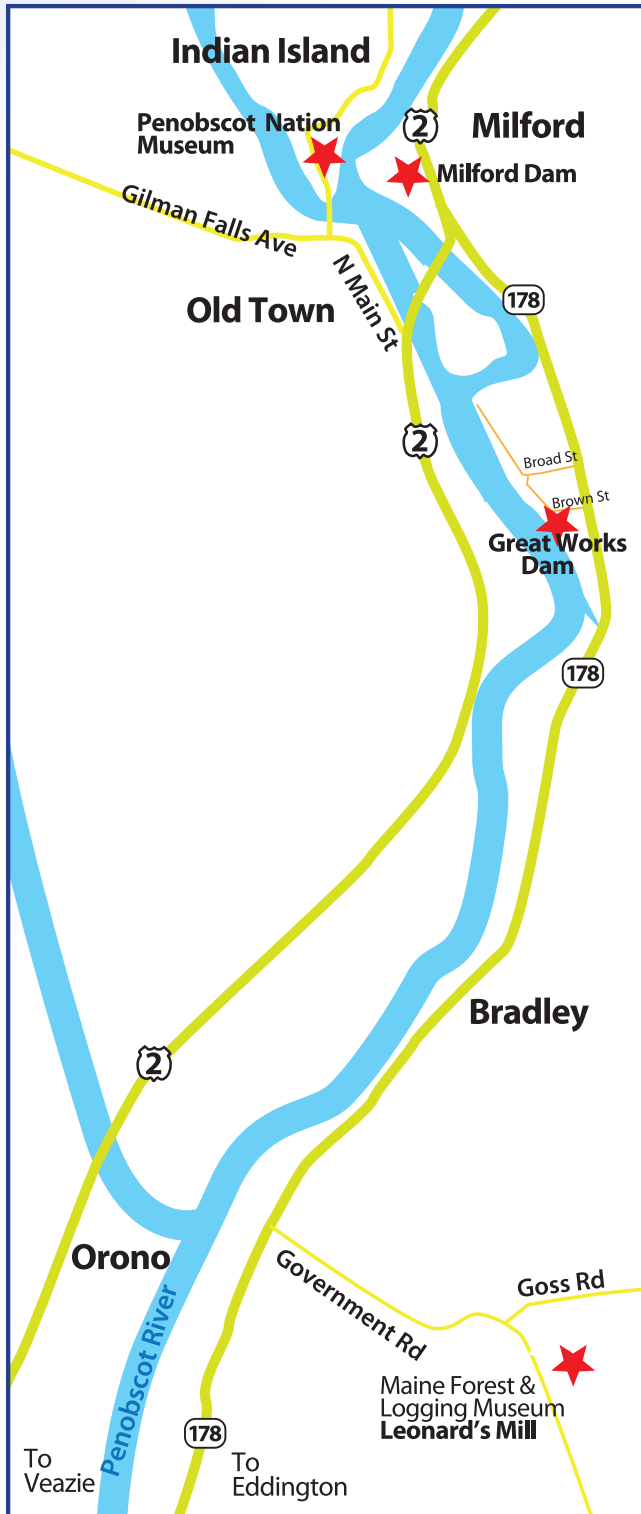


Self Guided Tour – Schedule and Description

We invite you to visit these Project sites on your own and hear scheduled presentations at the times noted below. You are free to visit the sites anytime between 2:30-5:00 when the sites will be staffed.



2:30 pm

Penobscot Indian Nation & Penobscot Nation Museum, Indian Island

Meet at the Gazebo on Indian Island to hear about the Penobscot Nation's cultural and historic connections to the river. Take a walk along the scenic boardwalk and visit the Penobscot Nation Museum.

3:10 pm

Milford Dam, Old Town Riverfront Park, Old Town

Learn about the hydropower benefits, the fish passage enhancements and the community benefits of the Penobscot River Restoration Project at this scenic park.

3:45 pm

Great Works Dam, Old Town

View the now free-flowing river and learn about the process of the Great Works dam removal and pre-dam removal science and monitoring efforts.

4:30 pm

Leonard's Mills, Bradley

Learn about the Blackman Stream rock and pool fishway that allows alewives access to spawning habitat in Chemo Pond and community collaborations to open up tributaries to the Penobscot River.
