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2 **Sec. FF-1. Working group; development of implementing legislation.** The
3 Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services shall convene a working group
4 to develop proposed legislation that transfers personnel, position counts and
5 responsibilities from the Executive Department, State Planning Office to other
6 departments and agencies of the State.

7 1. The members of the working group are:

8 A. The Director of the State Planning Office within the Executive Department or the
9 director's designee;

10 B. The Commissioner of Labor or the commissioner's designee;

11 C. The Commissioner of Public Safety or the commissioner's designee;

12 D. The Commissioner of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management or the
13 commissioner's designee;

14 E. The Commissioner of Conservation or the commissioner's designee;

15 F. The Commissioner of Economic and Community Development or the
16 commissioner's designee;

17 G. The Commissioner of Marine Resources or the commissioner's designee;

18 H. The Commissioner of Environmental Protection or the commissioner's designee;

19 I. One member of a local or regional governing body appointed by the President of
20 the Senate; and

21 J. One representative of a municipal or regional governing body appointed by the
22 Speaker of the House.

23 2. The Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services shall serve as the
24 chair of the working group.

25 3. The Executive Department, State Planning Office and the Department of
26 Administrative and Financial Services, Division of Financial and Personnel Services shall
27 provide staff assistance to the working group.

28 **Sec. FF-2. Report.** The working group shall submit its recommendations and any
29 related proposed legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and
30 Financial Affairs no later than December 1, 2011. The proposed legislation must include
31 recommendations for the disposition of programs in the Executive Department, State
32 Planning Office and a recommendation regarding the job title, duties and salary range for
33 the Director, State Planning Office position. After receipt and review of the report, the
34 joint standing committee may submit legislation to the Second Regular Session of the
35 125th Legislature to transfer duties and responsibilities from the State Planning Office to
36 other departments and agencies of State Government.
