Angus King is one of the principals of Independence Wind, LLC, a Maine company formed to develop large-scale wind power projects in Maine and New England. Angus King was Governor of Maine from 1995 to 2003. Elected in his first run for public office in 1994, he was re-elected in 1998 by one of the largest margins of victory in Maine history.

He is currently Of Counsel to the Bernstein, Shur law firm in Portland, teaches at Bowdoin College, and serves on the boards of and advises several Maine-based and international corporations. Prior to serving as Governor, he created and operated Northeast Energy Management, Inc., a developer of major electrical energy conservation projects in south central Maine.
