## **Callahan Cleanup Costs Top \$8 Million**

The Callahan Mine in Brooksville was closed more than 40 years ago, yet Maine taxpayers continue to pay cleanup costs for this ill-fated mine. The mine owner is long gone. The mine is a Superfund site. Appropriations have been made through the Maine Department of Transportation budget, starting in FY 2004. The LePage Administration budget request includes \$1.65 million for the next two years. Total cleanup costs were projected to be \$23 million, but are likely to be much higher. These mounting costs should serve as a warning to Maine lawmakers and the public about the potential long-term fiscal and environmental risks posed by mineral mining in Maine.
