



Directions: Katahdin Woods and Waters National Monument

Southern Entrance

- Take Interstate 95 to Sherman, Exit 264.
- Turn left (if you're coming from the south) or right (if you're coming from the north) off the exit, go approximately 1/8 mile, and take left onto Route 11 South (watch for the signs).
- Take Route 11 South for 5.2 miles (also known as the Grindstone Road).
- On a very sharp left hand turn, continue straight onto a gravel road – this is the Swift Brook Road.
- Travel 5.2 miles on the Swift Brook Road (one bridge crossing, go slowly). This is an active logging road, so be prepared to yield to trucks.
- You will come to a fork.
 - Bear left to reach the Loop Road in approximately 5 miles (crossing the East Branch of the Penobscot River along the way).
 - Bear right to reach Lunksoos Camps in approximately 3 miles.

Northern Entrance

- Take Interstate 95 to Sherman, Exit 264.
- Turn left (if you're coming from the south) or right (if you're coming from the north) off the exit.
- Continue on Route 11 North to Patten.
- In Patten, take a left onto Route 159. Continue on Route 159 for approximately 25 miles.
- Turn left onto a gravel road and travel approximately 1 mile to reach the Matagamom gate.
